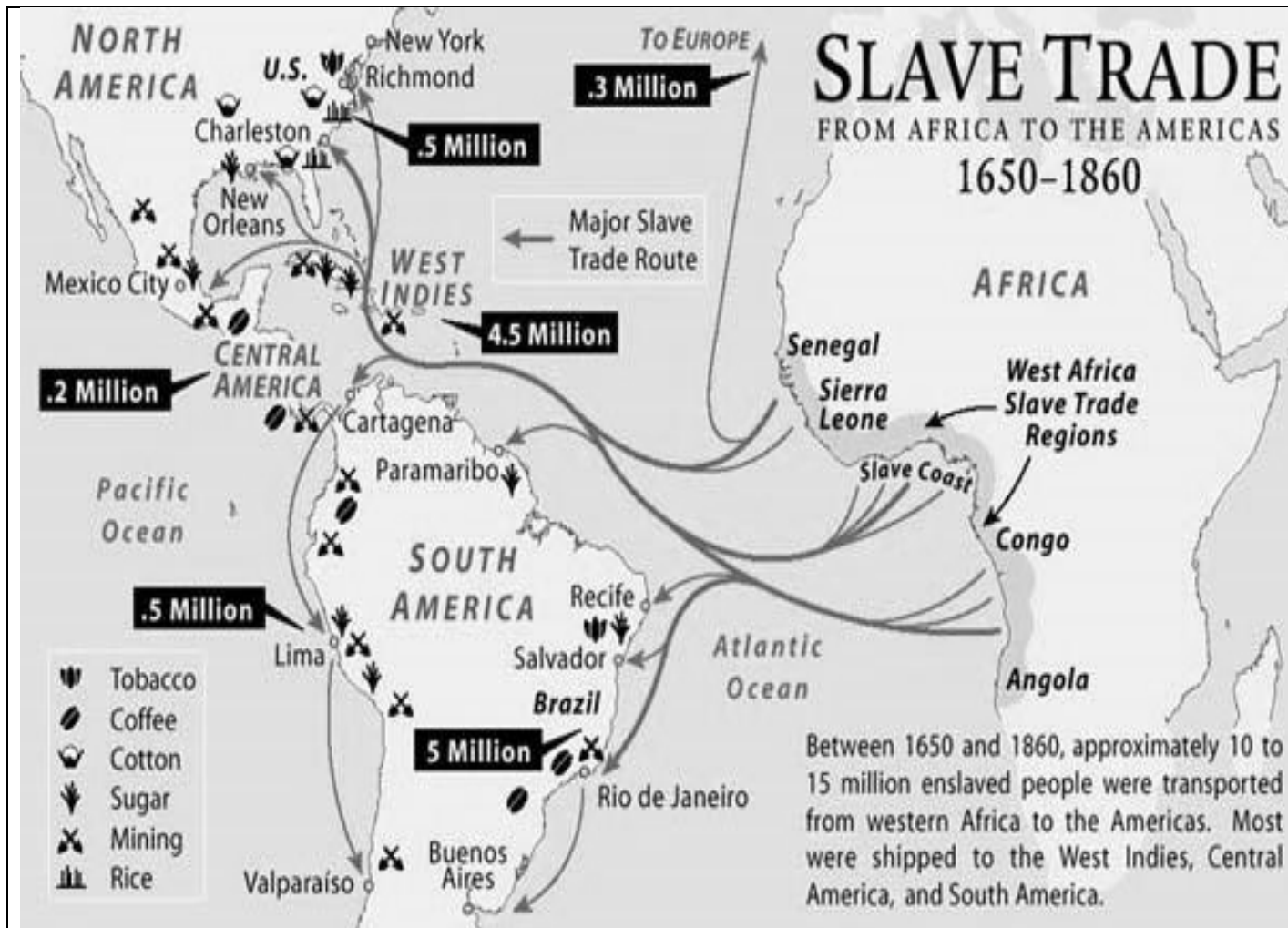
Ieyasu was a general in Nobunaga's army. After Hideyoshi's death, he took control of Japan. He was the first shogun of the Tokugawa shogunate.
